- the company is committed to complying with our compliance obligations including relevant H&S laws and regulations and with other requirements to which the organization subscribes.
- The company has a commitment to consult with workers on issues that concern their Occupational health and Safety.
- The health and safety performance of the company will be regularly monitored, and the company will strive to improve its performance.
- The company will set and review annual objectives for the improvement of occupational health and safety.
- The company will take appropriate measures to ensure that its customers are provided with all necessary information in the form of instructions and warnings to enable them to use its products safely.
- Safety of equipment will be ensured through regular maintenance and inspection using planned programmes.
- Employees, contractors, and visitors are required to adhere to the Company procedures.
